What are Mini-camps?

Mini camp fees

Mini camps – full day*: \$265 (4-day week - \$235)

* This applies to those who will be attending a half-day minicamp and spending the rest of the day in regular camp.

Camper Ages

Camp is available for students 18-months to rising 6th grade. Little Campers are 18-months to completed PK4; Big Campers are completed Kindergarten through 5th grade

Students in the 18-month class MUST be:

- > enrolled in Faith's ECE 1 class in the fall (2025-26)
- walking independently
- > self-feeding

Placement for all other campers will be determined by grade completed in the 2024-25 school year.

Emphasis will be placed on mastering phonemic awareness, letter/sound association, decoding, encoding, and phonics. Campers will practice age-appropriate decoding skills and reading fluency. Our camp will include a snack/recess time for our campers to rest and reset! Camp goals are to build skills and have fun while doing it! Minimum of 7 campers.






We are currently enrolling for all grades, 18-months – 5th grade, at Faith Lutheran School for the 2025-26 school year.
